Despite all the challenges the recent Covid spike has thrown our way, we intend to put on the best Sno*Drift possible. We have decided to cut back the schedule to accommodate our amazing volunteers. The course will have to be shortened, but we expect it to still be as challenging as ever. We look forward to bringing you the best time you can have in the Sno*!

The following changes (**bolded**) are made to the 2021 Supplemental Regulations for the 2021 Sno*Drift Rally.

1.2. Sno*Drift will take place on the roads of Montmorency County, Michigan. The entire event will take place on Saturday. The itinerary includes 9 stages totaling ~90 miles of recently plowed winter stage roads. The route is compact and takes place entirely within a 20 x 25 mile rectangular grid with a single, central service location.

3.1. Entry will open January 5, 2021 10:00 AM EST.

3.5. Entry fees include: Recce participation, one Service Crew Book, use of a single service spot.

3.6. If competitors would like Jemba notes provided to them, please email snodriftchair@gmail.com ,before January 14th 2021 with the request. If enough requests are taken, Jemba notes will be available at a fee of \$125 per vehicle.

7.7 Teams that did not complete the first **section** and intend to restart **in following sections** must arrange to be re-inspected prior to entering by making an appointment with the Chief Scrutineer. His cell is 260-579-3959.

10.1 Sno*Drift consists of **1** legs and **3** sections of 3-4 stages each. There will be no ARA RCR 6.3 option.

10.6 Stage start controls will close after the last car, or 15 minutes after the planned start time of the last car, whichever comes first. Stage finish controls will close upon the passing of the safety sweep crew. Teams that arrive at a start control after it closes are considered to have exceeded MPL and must immediately suspend from the competition (they will not be able to restart for points as noted in 10.1 above).
